<p><b>City of Edmonton</b></p>	<p>City Council has suspended all regularly scheduled City Council and Standing Committee meetings currently scheduled in the 2020 Council Calendar until 8am, on Monday, April 27, 2020, with the exception of the March 30, 2020, City Council meeting.</p> <p>The Emergency Advisory Committee currently meets virtually. <a href="#">Stream meetings here.</a></p> <p>See Council <a href="#">agendas and information here.</a></p>	<p>The Edmonton Service Center is closed to in person services. However, development officers are working remotely and are still processing development permit applications. Safety Codes officers are also working remotely and are still processing applications. Payments for DP and BP can be made via the usual methods – Visa for \$5000 or less and electronic transfer for more than \$5000. Land titles also remain open.</p> <p>Inspections for homes under construction will continue as normal. The city will be conducting a hazard assessment that includes asking any workers if they are sick or have been quarantined or have recently returned to Canada. Lot grading, transportation, and landscaping compliance inspections are scheduled to start when weather permits. These include no sick workers, no quarantined workers, and no recently returned workers. If workers are on site – social distancing rules must be followed. Site inspections for occupied homes (ex. renovations) will proceed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If there is a homeowner present, the SCO will contact the homeowner/applicant to determine if there are any sick or quarantined persons on site</li> <li>• If there are, you will either need to reschedule or submit a verification of compliance with pictures.
